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Formulation Guidelines

- 1. Start by slowly sprinkling Polyquaternium-10 into water with mixing until uniform.
- 2. Begin heating to 70-75°C.
- 3. Once Phase A is reaches approximately 65°C, start adding Phase B ingredients one at a time until mixed well between additions. Continue heating to 70-75°C. Allow to mix for 20 minutes.
- 4. Start cool down. Once Phase AB reaches $25\text{--}30^{\circ}\text{C}$, start adding Phase C mixing well between additions.
- $5.\ Pre-measure\ Phase\ D$ in a separate beaker, and slowly fold Phase ABC into Phase D with hand mixing.
- 6. Slowly add Phase E to ABCD with hand mixing.
- 7. Check pH. Adjust accordingly 4.5-5.5.

- 1. Combine Phase A. Heat to 80°C.
- 2. Combine Phase B. Heat to 80°C.
- 3. At temperature, add phase B to Phase A. Mix thoroughly for approximately 30 minutes.
- 4. Begin cool down.
- 5. At 50-60°C, add Phase C ingredients individually, mixing well between additions.

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Formulation Guidelines

- 1. Combine Phase A with heat up to 70-75°C.
- 2. At temperature, add Phase B to Phase A. Mix with heat until homogenized.
- 3. Heat Phase C to approximately 80°C.
- 4. Add Phase C to Phase AB and mix well. Homogenize briefly.
- 5. Begin cool down.
- 6. Add Phase D at approximately 50°C. Mix well.
- 7. Add Phase E to Phase ABCD. Mix well. Continue cool down to approximately 30°C.
